Tips before you start:

- While on the CCHS campus, use a computer that's already behind the CCHS firewall.
- Use a Windows PC or Laptop to get to the portal (not an Apple/Mac) for best results.
- If you are off campus, use Juno's Pulse to connect remotely to the portal on your CCHS device.
- Use Internet Explorer 9, 10 or 11 (not Chrome, Mozilla or Safari).

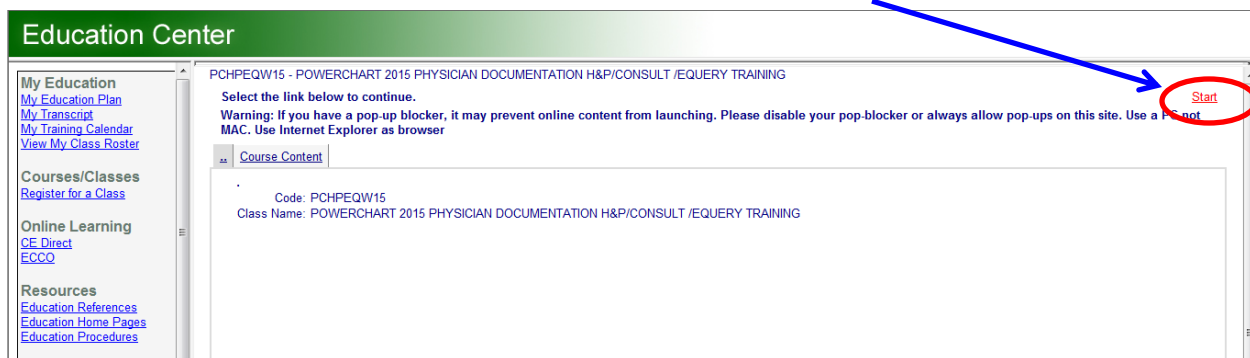
